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Data Subject Rights Procedures

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Introduction

This document outlines the procedures for ensuring compliance with the data subject rights under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and other applicable data protection laws.

Rights of Data Subjects

Data subjects have the following rights regarding their personal data processed by Brytend B.V.:

Right to Access: Data subjects can request access to their personal data.

Right to rectification: Data subjects can request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data.

Right to Erasure: Data subjects can request the deletion of their data under certain conditions.

Right to Restrict Processing: Data subjects can request the restriction of processing of their data.

Right to Data Portability: Data subjects can request a copy of their data in a machine-readable format.

Right to Object: Data subjects can object to the processing of their data.

Rights in relation to Automated Decision Making and Profiling: Data subjects can request human intervention in automated decision-making processes.

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Procedures

- 1. Receiving Requests:
- All requests must be submitted to the designated contact point, preferably via the official form provided by Brytend B.V.
- Requests can also be made verbally or in writing.
- 2. Identification:
- Verify the identity of the data subject making the request to prevent unauthorized access to personal data.
- 3. Assessment:
- Determine the validity of the request and assess whether it can be fulfilled within the legal framework.
- 4. Fulfillment:
- Respond to the data subject without undue delay and in any event within one month of receipt of the request.
- If the request is complex or numerous, the period may be extended by two further months.
- 5. Documentation:
- Keep records of all requests and the actions taken in response to them.

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6. Denial of Requests:

• If a request is denied, provide the data subject with a clear explanation of the reasons for the denial and information about their right to complain to a supervisory authority.

7. Training:

• Ensure that all staff members who may receive or process such requests are adequately trained.
